

Privacy Policy

Effective Date: January 1, 2026

Miracle for Judge (“we,” “our,” or “the Campaign”) is committed to respecting your privacy and protecting your personal information. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how we use it, and how we keep it secure when you interact with our website or campaign.

I. Information We Collect

1. When you visit our website, sign up to volunteer, donate, or request information, we may collect:
2. Personal Information: such as your name, email address, phone number, mailing address, and payment details when you provide them voluntarily.
3. Donor Information: as required by campaign finance law, we may also collect your occupation and employer when you make a donation.
4. Automatically Collected Data: such as your IP address, browser type, device information, and pages you visit on our website.

II. How We Use Information

We use the information we collect to:

1. Communicate with you about campaign updates, events, and opportunities to support Kaycee.
2. Process contributions and comply with all applicable campaign finance reporting requirements.
3. Improve our website and outreach strategies.
4. Respond to your inquiries or requests.

III. How We Share Information

1. We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information. We may share data only in the following limited ways:
2. With Service Providers who help us operate our website, process donations, or send communications, and who are required to safeguard your information.
3. As Required by Law, including compliance with campaign finance disclosure laws or other applicable legal obligations.

IV. Cookies and Tracking

Our website may use cookies and other tracking technologies to measure site performance, improve functionality, and understand how visitors interact with our content. You may disable cookies in your browser settings, though some features may not work properly.

V. Security of Your Information

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or misuse. However, no system is entirely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute protection.

VI. Children's Privacy

Our website and campaign activities are not directed toward children under 13, and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children.

VII. Your Choices

You may opt out of receiving campaign communications at any time by clicking "unsubscribe" in our emails or contacting us directly. You may also request that we update or delete your personal information.
